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## New Lake Rules for 2017

With the help of an advisory committee, the board has made some changes to the lake rules for the coming season. The goal is to reduce usage by unaccompanied non-residents.

If you'd like to host a get together at the lake this summer, book your date early through the office. Party permits will be posted at the gazebo. No permits will be given for Sundays between Memorial Day and Labor Day to allow for quieter family time at the lake. A deposit is required if you will erect a tent. No bounce houses will be allowed.

Gate key cards are available in the office. If you have one, it is already activated and ready to use. Vehicle stickers must be adhered to the driver's side lower corner of the windshield to park inside the gate. Guests must park in the preschool parking lot and NOT on JW Drive.

Please be considerate of other users. Keep dogs away from the sandy beach and picnickers. Poop bags are provided at several stations. Please keep music volume low and point speakers toward the highway as sound travels over water.

This property belongs to you as homeowners. If you see someone doing something they shouldn't be doing, ask them to stop or call the sheriff's department. Report incidents to our office.

Non-motorized boats may be stored on the west side of the lake. There is a \$25 annual permit fee and a registration sticker must be displayed. Please contact the office for more information. Unregistered or unlocked boats will be impounded.

The beach bathrooms will reopen sometime in May after the threat of freezing has past. The bathroom code is 5-3-1. and never changes.

## El Jebel Road Construction

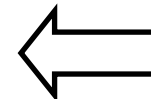
Work on the new round-about is slated to begin April 12th. Please plan accordingly.
